

Let's see the 20 best lakes in Arizona! best lakes in arizona for fishingarizona is home to a number of lakes that are famous for fish ranging from cat fish, down, to trout and beyond. we will dive into some of the best lakes for fishing in Arizona.1) bartlett lake, green river, 50 miles ne of phoenixbartlett lake is one of the best lakes in arizona to catch the catfish! rostislav Stefanek/Shutterstock. with the bartlett lake is known for its record breaking catfish. anglers can enjoy recreational fishing and tournament. Besides excellent catfish fishing you can find largemouth bass and bluegills. the bartlett lake has 12 miles long and over 2.830 hectares. The biggest catfish was caught here in 2013 by eddie wilcoxson. you can imagine a catfish that is 76 pounds and 53 inches long! That's big fish! The largest carp in Arizona was also caught in the bartlett lake, by jonathan gardner, weighed 37 pounds and was 40 inches long.2) big lake, springerville, about 200 miles and phoenixbruce Grubbs/Shutterstock. with great. Lake certainly does not receive the prize for the most creative name, but it is a great lake. is in the white mountains and is considered a fishing lake. is known as some of the best fishing trout, including rainbow trout, brook trout and cutthroat trout.3) mead lake, arizona border and snowed 24 miles and las vegas mead pond is a popular location for bass fishing.iStock.com/Sean pavone if you are looking for some of the best bass fishing lake mead is the place. is the largest reservoir of the statesand is formed by the Hoover Dam on the Colorado River. The first B.A.S.S bassmaster cluestile hosted in Lake Mead in 1971. Boating and swimming are also popular activities at Lake Mead National Recreation Area.4) Lake Mohave, Border of Arizona and Nevada, about 100 SE miles from Las VegasLuxurious Lake Mohave. It is stocked with low and trout and is hot most of the year. It's 21,491 acres along the Salt River. Because of its popularity, many fish breaking records were captured in their waters as the smallest bass (7lb.96 oz, 22.75 inches), bigmouth buffalo fish (36lb 6 oz, 38.5 inches), and flathead catfish (catch and launch, 53 inches!).6) Martinez Lake, Yuma, 3 hour SE drive from PhoenixMartinez Lake is a jewel located near Yuma, Arizona.KDzPloch/Shutterstock. with One of the hidden gems for fishing is Martinez Lake in Arizona SE corner.
